Aero2 and Polkomtel with a shared infrastructure

Aero2, a subsidiary of the Warsaw Stock Exchange-listed fund NFI Midas, and the operator of the Plus network have signed an agreement under which both companies will share their telecom infrastructure.

Regarding the provision of services with the aid of the telecom infrastructure, the signed agreement lays down the regulations of cooperation between Aero2 and Polkomtel, whereby each of them will permit the other to use its telecom infrastructure and both of them will mutually provide services for the benefit of their telecom operations.

In the agreement, the companies undertake to provide each other with SITE, RAN and, optionally, SITE transmissions. Thanks to the agreement, Aero2 and Polkomtel will be able to install telecom equipment at each other's base stations, or directly commission telecom services from each other.

Individual services will be provided on the basis of written orders. The estimated value of Aero2's first order for RAN services, to be provided for a period of 5 years, is PLN 144.5 million.

The signing of the agreement is another step in the fulfilment of NFI Midas' strategy to establish a modern telecom operator providing ultrafast mobile Internet in LTE/HSPA+ technology. The agreement will allow both companies to reduce costs considerably and speed up the expansion of the telecom network by sharing their infrastructure, including their base stations. It will also optimize the technology of both networks and ensure a better quality of telecom service for each Party's end users.

The cooperation of the two telecom operators on the basis of the signed agreement will increase the area of Poland where data can be transmitted with the use of LTE/HSPA+ technology.
