Ericsson building an infrastructure for Plus and Aero2!

On 23 July 2012, Polkomtel Sp. z o.o., operator of the Plus network, and Aero2 Sp. z o.o., a subsidiary of NFI Midas, concluded with Ericsson Sp. z o.o. a framework agreement for the delivery, integration and maintenance of components of cellular telephony, as well as a maintenance contract.

Ericsson undertook to provide WCDMA and LTE technologies, permitting the most modern data transmission services. Ericsson guarantees the best possible solutions regarding network reliability and efficiency, and ensures that the new equipment and software are compatible with the current facilities of the existing network. Ericsson also undertook to cooperate fully with other providers of equipment and software for Plus and Aero2.

The signed agreements will help modernize and expand the WCDMA and LTE networks in northern and western Poland and adapt the skeleton network to broadband services.

"Ericsson is a long-standing partner of Plus. I am pleased that after months of preparations we have signed an agreement with that European partner" – said Wojciech Pytel, member of the Management Board of Polkomtel Sp. z o.o. – "I am sure that together we can fulfil the demands of our customers for interactive and mobile broadband in Poland."

"The agreement tightens the cooperation between Ericsson on the one hand and Plus and Aero2 on the other, and also allows the implementation of Ericsson's latest technological know-how in Poland" – said Krzysztof Burzyński, member of the Management Board of Ericsson Sp. z o.o.

The agreement for the delivery, integration and maintenance of components of cellular telephony was concluded for a period of 3 years, after which it will become an agreement valid indefinitely. The maintenance agreement was concluded for a period of 120 months.
