NFI Midas: Another order for data transmission service

Mobyland, a subsidiary of NFI Midas, has received a second order for data transmission services from Cyfrowy Polsat. The value of the order exceeds PLN 100 million net.

Cyfrowy Polsat has ordered from Mobyland a new package of 13 million gigabytes of data worth PLN 103 million net. This successive order from Cyfrowy Polsat is the result of great interest in ultrafast mobile Internet and its increasing availability. At present, with the aid of over one thousand base stations, the Group's companies ensure ultrafast Internet access to an area comprising over 22,000 localities.

Under the agreement with Cyfrowy Polsat, NFI Midas provides access to wireless data transmission service in 1800 and 900 Mhz, in LTE or HSPA+ technology. The technology allows data to be downloaded at a speed of up to 100 Mb/s and sent at up to 50 MB/s.

"This successive order from Cyfrowy Polsat is the outcome of an agreement we signed in 2012 and which stipulated the placing of this order when Mobyland had more than 900 base stations," says Wojciech Pytel, President of the Management Board of NFI Midas S.A.

Apart from Cyfrowy Polsat, the ultrafast mobile Internet offered by the NFI Midas Group is also available in the Polkomtel mobile telephone network.
